Arvada West H.S. Foundation Scholarship - Due March 11, 2024

In 2012, AWHS alumni created the Arvada West High School Foundation to assist graduates in their pursuit of a secondary education. Since that time, the Foundation has awarded over \$187,000 to eighty graduates.

When selecting scholarship recipients, the Foundation considers the following:

- A minimum Grade Point Average of 2.5 (unweighted)
- Intention to attend an accredited two-year, four-year, or trade / technical school following their graduation (as confirmed by an acceptance letter and student identification number from the school)
- Completion of the Scholarship Application Package (see box below)
- *Further consideration will be given for applicants as follows:*
 - *demonstrated financial need*
 - unique family circumstances
 - 1st generation secondary education

APPLICATION DIRECTIONS for applying for a Foundation Scholarship—please provide the following:

- A *cover letter* that provides biographical information and how your high school experiences have prepared you for post-high school plans (*maximum one page*).
- A completed *application* (see page 2).
- A copy of your OFFICIAL high school *transcript*.
- Two letters of *recommendation*, one of which must be from a certified high school staff person and preferably one from outside the school (*maximum of one page each*).
- A *personal essay* that indicates your post-high school plans, your desired career intentions, and the most significant influences and how incidents during your high school years that have prepared you for post-high school plans (*minimum of one page maximum two pages*).
- Note that submission of this application qualifies you for consideration as a recipient of the Foundation's renewable LEGACY scholarship.
